<DDP Dream in Light>

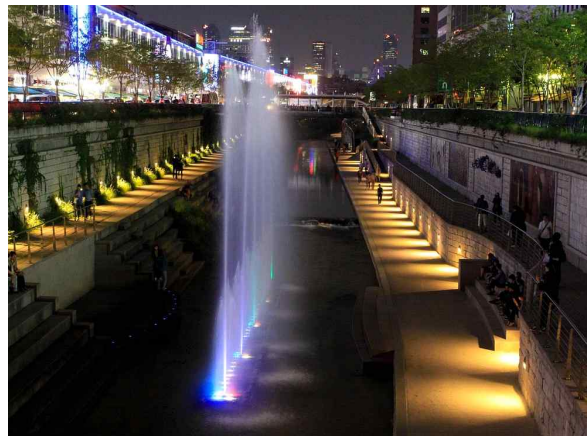
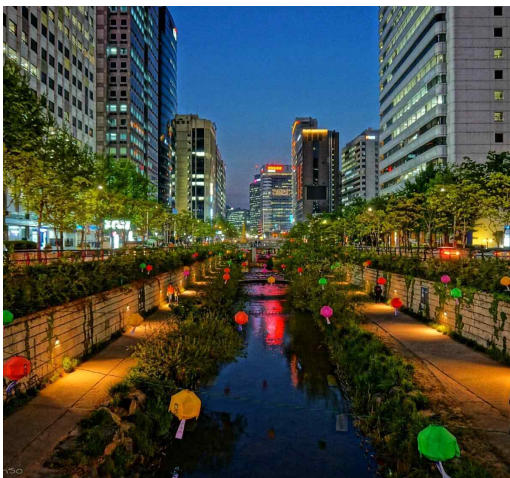
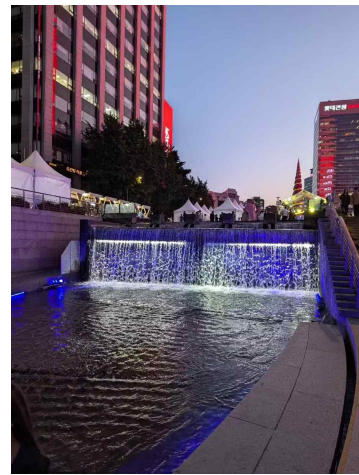
